Category A Documents: *Primary Photographic Identification documents*

- Current Australian Passport (or one that has expired within last 2 years)
- Current Driver's Licence, containing photograph
- Current Australian Proof of Age card, containing photograph
- Current Passport issued by a foreign government

Category B Documents: *Primary Non-photographic Identification documents*

- Birth Certificate or Birth Extract issued by the Australian Government or a foreign government
- Citizenship certificate issued by the Australian Government or a foreign government
- Pension card / Seniors card / Medicare card / DVA card / Health care card or any other entitlement card issued by the Australian Government

Category C Documents: *Secondary Identification documents*

- Benefit notice issued by Australian, State or Territory governments within the last 12 months
- Tax assessment notice issued by the Australian Taxation Office within the last 12 months
- Council rates notice or utilities bill issued within the last 3 months, containing Residential Address

CHILD UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE – Any of the following documents:

- Birth certificate or Birth extract issued by the Australian Government or a foreign government
- Notice issued by School Principal within the last 3 months, containing Date of Birth or Residential Address
- Student Identification card, containing Date of Birth
